Collections	<p>The CAA includes a permanent research and teaching campus of classrooms, dorms, laboratories, library, museum and artifact repository. Archaeological collections represent more than 50 years of continuous research in a 3000-square-mile area of west-central Illinois, including major excavations and controlled surface collections from more than 3700 sites. In addition to an estimated 11 million archaeological and ecofactual specimens and more than one-half million supporting documents, photographs and maps, the Center maintains major comparative collections for archaeological botany, zoology and human osteology.</p>
