General Description / Special Programs	The Anthropology program at COCC includes introductory courses in Cultural Anthropology, Physical Anthropology, and Archaeology, as well as specialized courses in Gender and Sexuality, and Magic, Witchcraft, and Religion. Students at COCC can take up to 8 credits through the OSU-Cascades partners. The University of Oregon, Bend program offers 300 and 400 level anthropology courses as well as archaeological field school opportunities in Central Oregon. The High Desert Museum, the Deschutes and Ochoco National Forests, and the BLM offer internships and seasonal employment opportunities.
