General Description / Special Programs	The LESC (Laboratoire d'ethnologie et de sociologie comparative) is a research centre in social and cultural anthropology of the University of Paris Ouest (Nanterre) and the CNRS (National Center for Scientific Research). It has over 50 tenured anthropologists and one hundred graduate students, a research library, and ethnographic archives (Griaule, Pitt-Rivers, etc.). It includes two specialized teams, on Ethnomusicology and on Amerindian studies. The LESC develops a comparative approach relying on case studies. It combines an expertise in the ""core"" topics of anthropology (kinship, religion, politics, linguistics, ethnomusicology) while exploring novel issues (robotics, morality).
